SPRINGing Into Better Hearing Aid Hygiene

With warmer weather approaching, follow these simple tips to keep you and/or your children's hearing aids clean and functional:

- Utilize hearing aid dryers and AudioWipes to keep hearing aids and molds sanitized and dry, especially after spending time outside.
- Leave hearing aids off and/or at home if you're spending time in or around water.
- Designate a safe, clean, and dry place at home *and* school to put hearing aids when they're not being worn.
- Download the manufacturer app for your specific hearing aids - simple, at-home troubleshooting tips are readily available to avoid an unnecessary trip to the audiologist!
